Dr. Keating is a renowned family gerontologist with special expertise in rural and international aging family and relationships. Her scholarship has been supported by continuous funding since 1975 from government agencies and universities in Canada, USA, Australia, United Kingdom, and New Zealand. A fellow of both the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences and the Gerontological Society of America, Dr. Keating has received many prestigious awards and recognitions for her research and scholarly contributions. She is currently serving as Director for the Global Social Initiative on Ageing of the International Association of Gerontology and Geriatrics. She has published 136 peer-reviewed articles, presented her research at conferences around the globe, provided extensive service to national and international professional organizations, and consulted with universities in South Africa and other countries seeking to develop family gerontology education and research programs.
