***If You Should Survive to 105: Population-
Based Perspectives on Very Long Lives***

Dr. Davey is a developmental psychologist with training in Human Development and Family Studies from the Pennsylvania State University. Prior to joining the faculty at Temple University, he was Senior Research Scientist at the Polisher Research Institute and an Associate Professor at the University of Georgia. Dr. Davey's research addresses issues of marital and intergenerational relationships, family caregiving, and comparative analysis of the interface between formal and informal care networks, particularly in the United States, Great Britain, and Sweden.
